As a part of a five-year award, Furman University will provide:

- RESEARCH SALARIES of \$ 5,000 (NIH-INBRE, tax withheld) OR,
- SUMMER STIPENDS of \$ 4,500 (no tax withheld) to students from other SC institutions participating in 10 weeks of full-time research.

DATES: May 17 through July 23. (Starting/ending dates are flexible with permission of the research advisor.)

FURMAN FACULTY: Participants work directly with Furman faculty members in exciting areas of biomedical research based on background and interest.

PRESENTATION and AUTHORSHIP: A primary goal for all participants will be presentation at a regional or national meeting (*travel funding also provided*), with the additional possibility of coauthorship on refereed publications.

APPLICATION: Students from groups traditionally underrepresented in the sciences are encouraged to apply.
